

# PARK RULES

2009

1. Members/Residents only, Guests must be accompanied by member.
2. No alcohol is permitted in the park.
3. Park hours are day light to dusk. Exception if pavilion is reserved by a current member, private party can stay until 10PM. Please respect private parties being held at the pavilion.
4. All waste/trash must be disposed of in trash receptacles.
5. Dogs must be on a leash. Pet's waste must be picked up and disposed of properly in a plastic bag.
6. No glass containers.
7. Minor children of residents and resident's guests MUST be accompanied by an authorized adult Member at all times.
8. Waters Edge Community Association is not responsible for any items left at the park.
9. No gasoline motors- motors must be wrapped in plastic bag and be raised out of the water at all times.
10. No sailboats
11. Only rod, reel and pole fishing alone. Members do not need a fishing license to fish in the Park Lake, BUT member's guests do need a fishing license. Hooks, lures and broken fishing line etc. is no to be left on the ground.
12. No floats, trot lines, set hooks, gill nets, throw nets etc. Allowed.
13. No turtle traps allowed on park property.
14. No ATV's in park.
15. No skateboarding in park.
16. Vandalism or destruction of park property, pavilion or any private property within park will result in FULL prosecution by the law.
17. Unauthorized vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense. No cars, RV's, trailers etc. allowed to park overnight. No golf carts pass parking lot.
18. Violation of park rules will result in revoking park and lake privileges of the member for a year.
19. Any non authorized individual found on the park premises will be reported to the Locust Grove Police Department for trespassing.

## LAKE RULES

1. **NO GASOLINE MOTORS - MOTORS MUST BE WRAPPED IN PLASTIC BAG AND RAISED OUT OF THE WATER, AT ALL TIMES.**
2. **NO SAIL BOATS ALLOWED.**
3. **ONLY ROD, REEL & POLE FISHING ALLOWED.**
4. **NO FLOATS, TROT LINES, SET HOOKS, GILL NETS THROW NETS, ETC, ALLOWED.**
5. **TURTLE TRAPS ARE ALLOWED WITHIN YOUR PROPERTY LINE.**
6. **NO FISHING TOURNAMENTS ALLOWED.**
7. **ALL NON-RESIDENTS OF WATER'S EDGE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION MUST HAVE A VALID GEORGIA FISHING LICENSE ON THEIR PERSON WHILE FISHING.**
8. **ALL MUST SHOW I. D. IF ASKED. NON WATER'S EDGE RESIDENTS ARE ALLOWED (GUEST) WHEN ACCOMPANED BY A WATER'S EDGE ASSOCIATION MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING.**
9. **GRASS CARP MUST NOT BE REMOVED FROM THE LAKE – IF CAUGHT, PLEASE THROW THEM BACK.**
10. **YELLOW PERCH ARE EATING ALL THE SMALL FISH – IF YOU CATCH A YELLOW PERCH DO NOT PUT THEM BACK, REGARDLESS OF SIZE.**
11. **CREEL LIMITS:**

12. **BE COURTEOUS, DON'T ENCROACH ON SOMEONE ELSE'S FISHING SPOT. THE LAKE IS OPEN FOR FISHING 24 HOURS, KEEP IN MIND RESIDENTS MAY BE SLEEPING, SHOW RESPECT – NO LOUD TALKING OR NOISES ALLOWED AT ANY TIME.**
13. **ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED – HOWEVER, DRUNKENNESS IS NOT. IF ANYONE IS FOUND DRUNK AND DISORDERLY THEIR PARK AND LAKE PRIVILEGES WILL BE REVOKED. RESPECT ALL PROPERTY PARK PRIVATE PROPERTY AS WELL AS ALL PARK FACILITIES..**

## PARK RESOLUTION: GUEST POLICY

Park space is open to residents of WATERS EDGE SUBDIVISION. All guests to the park must be accompanied by a resident of WATERS EDGE. A resident may bring their family and up to four additional guests, or another family to the park. Family is defined as those individuals related by blood, marriage, domestic partnership, and/or adoption. Any number of guests beyond previously stated, will require the completion of the pavilion rental policy. The rental policy includes a \$25 rental fee and a \$25 refundable, clean-up fee.
